- Release of Liability

I understand dance can be a strenuous activity and accept responsibility for any injuries my child may incur while participating in any activity at Power Dance. Power Dance and its employees are not liable for personal injury, or loss of or damage to personal property

- Spectator Policy

Classes are closed to spectators. This policy keeps kids focused and all students feeling comfortable.

- Photo Release

- Payment Policy

2021-2022 registration and tuition payment information: 1. Tuition/fees/payments are all non refundable. 2. There is a yearly registration fee due when registering for fall classes. \$25 per student or \$40 per family. 3. Tuition may be paid by ACH, check, credit/debit card, or cash. You may put payments in the dropbox located at the front desk. If payment is not received by the 5th of the month we will charge the card on file. 4. If tuition is not paid by the 7th of the month due to declined card or returned check a \$20 late fee will be applied to the account. Also, if late tuition continues, your student will not be allowed in class until tuition is paid. 5. There will be a \$25 processing fee on all returned checks. 6. Tuition amount will be the same each month, regardless of the number of classes or absences. Students can visit another class recommended by the teacher for their makeup. Snow days and severe weather days have been accounted for in tuition pricing. There will be no refunds or credits for missed classes. You are paying for your students' spots in class, not just the classes they attend. 7. If a student needs to drop out of a class, the studio must be notified, in writing, 2 weeks before payment due date. 8. Enrolling in a class/camp and holding your child's place in class results in paying for the class. Payment will be ran from the card/acct you have on file. Anywhere from the day you enroll to the day camp/class is held.

- Costume Policy

Costume payments are non refundable. Costume payments are due by Nov 15th. Costumes will not be handed out to families with outstanding balances. This includes tuition and all other fees. Students can not participate in recital without the appropriate costumes. Dropping from class results in forfeiting your costume and all fees paid. Recital t-shirts are mandatory for the spring recital. We will charge accounts on April 15th. If participating in our Christmas Showcase ordering a Studio shirt will be required. Participation is optional.
